



Budget

- ► Total Budget for 2022 is approximately \$309,097,792.00
 - ► MHIDD = \$36,198,101.00
 - ► HSD = \$17,339,854.00
 - ► CYF = \$63,947,933.00
 - ► AAA = \$9,941,000.00
 - ► HC = \$170,941,000.00
 - ► YADAC = \$7,086,332.00
 - ► YDC = \$3,664,172.00

HealthChoices Management Unit

Responsibilities

- Oversee mental health and drug and alcohol services available through the Medical Assistance Program called HealthChoices
- Contract with a managed care company (Community Care Behavioral Health) to deliver many day-to-day functions of the program
- Ensure services and planning for the program is focused on the priorities of the County
- Work with other departments who manage behavioral health programs



- Mission: Promote the independence of older adults through education, advocacy and coordination of community-based services.
- ► **Population:** older adults (60+) with the greatest social or economic needs

Mental Health Services

Mission: Provide support and necessary services to individuals living with mental illness and/or substance abuse problems so they can enhance their quality of life and provide themselves with an opportunity to reach their fullest potential.

Population: Individuals with serious and persistent mental illness

Intellectual Disabilities (ID)


- ► Population: individuals who possess an IQ of 69 and below.
- Services: Support Coordination (age 3+) Family Support Services, Community Employment, Transportation, Adult Developmental Training (ADT)



Early Intervention

Population: Age birth- 3 years; with or at-risk for developmental delays

Services: Assessments, Nutrition Services, Physical Therapy, Nursing Services, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Special Instruction, etc.



Drug & Alcohol Commission

Mission: Serve with respect, individuals in our community with substance abuse problems in order to enhance their quality of life

Services:

- Treatment
- Prevention
- Intervention



Youth Development Center

Mission: To provide a safe and healthy environment for all youth, where short-term emotional, physical, educational, social, and spiritual needs are accommodated.



YDC Services

- ► Thirty-six (36) bed shelter
- Placed by JPO or CYF through the court system; short-term
- Subscribe to the principles of the Sanctuary Model
- Community Outreach
