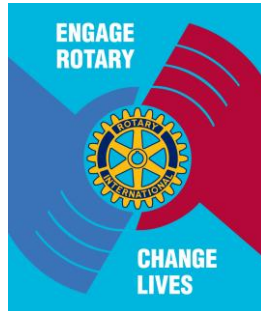

We hold only 1 fundraiser each year and that is our golf outing. This event raises the money to keep our club going.
