York East Dues: What is Covered and What You Need to Pay

As a member of the Rotary Club of York East, your dues not only cover our in-person meeting expensesBut also sustain the organization and its legacy of giving. As a member of Rotary District 7390 and Rotary International, we are assessed dues on each member by each of the two organizations.

The Board of Directors decided at our February meeting that we will continue to do virtual meetings through the end of March, deciding in March whether to resume inperson meetings. Because of that, we delayed invoicing you, our members, for the 1st quarter dues typically sent out in January. You will be receiving an invoice in the next week or two for those dues, and you do have the option to pay the normal \$180 quarterly payment for January through March 2021, or pay just the portion of your District and International dues, which is \$40.
