## A Message from our President



Hello York East Rotarians!

#### **District 7390 Annual Fund Trends:**

You may recall that when contributions are made to the Annual Fund, those dollars are then held for 3 years as investments. After 3 years, half of the dollars are used for international projects, etcs... and the other half is returned to the district. The District then decides how to deploy those funds. In general funds are used for international grants supporting district clubs as well as for our local district grants (up to \$2,500 a year).

Here is a summary of District 7390's Annual Fund Contributions:

- 2015-16 \$306,000
- 2016-17 \$320,000
- 2017-18 \$159,000
- 2018-19 227,000

What happened and why is this important? The large spikes were due to the 100 year anniversary of the Annual Fund. We need to continue supporting the Annual Fund which in turn supports local as well as international efforts to make a difference in people's lives.

#### **District Grant Project Update:**

For the 19-20 year, our club's district grant project was the scoreboard replacement in the gymnasium of the Salvation Army. As part of the district grant, on August 27<sup>th</sup> members of our club helped with assembly of carts and totes for use in the gym and staging of some rooms in the community center for their open house. I would like to thank all of those that were able to help that evening.
