Hello York East Rotarians!

This month I would like to share a snapshot of the face of our District 7390. Membership has been flat and slightly declining for the past years ranging from approximately 2,340 on July 1, 2015 to approximately 2,280 at June 30, 2019. Summary of the district membership for the 18-19 year:

  - 0 50-59 345
  - 0 60-69-410
  - o 70 and over 479
  - o Unreported 691
- Gender:
  - o Females 611
  - o Males 1,660
