

Displaying Participants on a Mobile Device

The Zoom mobile app on Android and iOS supports active speaker or gallery view.



[Start](#) or [join](#) a meeting. By default, the Zoom mobile app displays the active speaker view. If one or more participants joins the meeting, you will see a video thumbnail in the bottom-right corner.



Swipe left from the active speaker view to switch to gallery view.

You can gallery view up to 4 participants' at the same time. You can keep swiping left to view more participants' video.



Swipe right to the first screen to switch back to active speaker view.

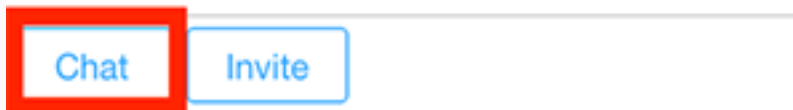


Accessing Chat from a Mobile Device

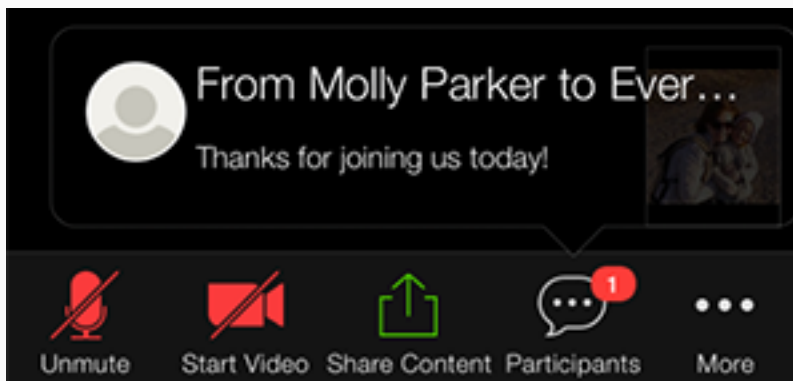
1. While in a meeting, tap the screen to make the controls appear.
2. Click on **Participants**.



3. At the bottom of the participants list, click on **Chat**.



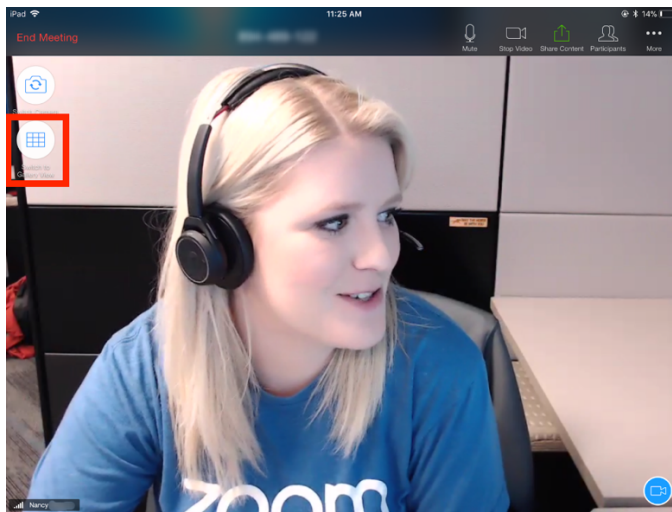
4. You can type your chat message and click **Send** or if you want to change who it is being sent to, click the arrow next to Send to: and choose a different person or group of people.
5. Incoming chats will be displayed at the bottom of your screen and you can click on **Participants** then **Chat** to view them.



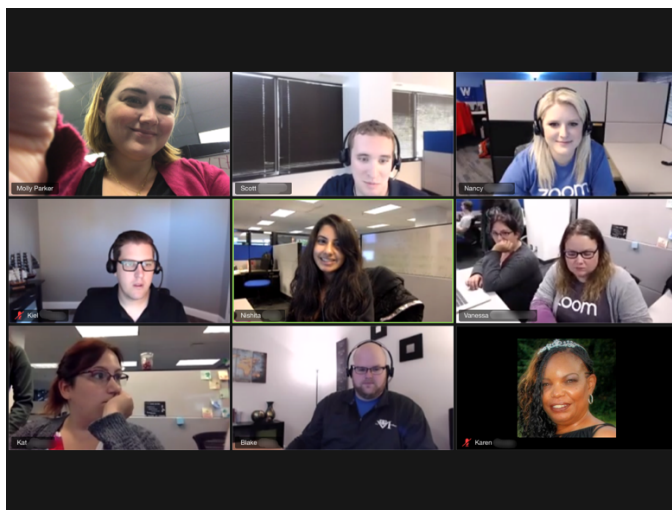
6. You can also click on MORE to find the Chat switch.

Zoom on an iPad

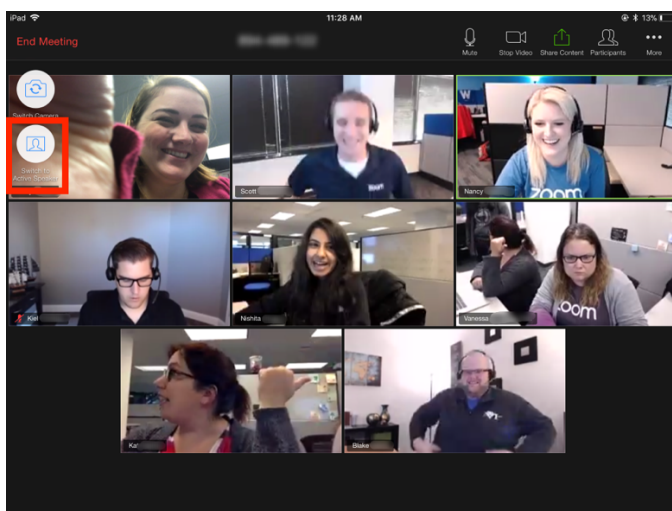
The Zoom mobile app on iPad supports active speaker or gallery view. Gallery view allows you to see up to 9 participants at once. By default the iPad starts in Active Speaker View.



To switch from active speaker view, tap **Switch to Gallery View** in the upper-left corner of the Zoom window. Don't see the controls? Tap your screen to get them to appear.



This will switch into gallery view. You can view up to 9 people at a time.



To switch back to active speaker, tap the screen to view the controls and tap **Switch to Active Speaker** in the upper left corner of the Zoom
