## ***What are key things I need to know about the Celtic Classic 5K?***

Here is a quick summary.

- Racers will lead off the Celtic Classic Tartan Parade
- Same race route as 2024
- 10:00 a.m. - Race day registration & bib pickup on Sand Island
- 11:30 a.m. - Start of 5K at Bethlehem City Hall
- Course: Parade route to D&L Trail
- Finish: Sand Island by tennis courts
- Chip timing
- Awards (male & female, overall, age groups)
- Kilts are optional, but crowd loves 'em!

## ***Where do I register for the 2025 Celtic Classic 5K?***

1. Returning users sign in with your RunSignup account. First time users need to create an account.
2. Choose "2025 Celtic Classic 5K Run/Walk."
3. Pay via credit or debit card.
4. Register as an individual or add your friends to run as a team.

## ***Must I pre-register?***

No. Day-of-race registration will be available beginning at 10:00 a.m.

## ***Where is bib pickup and race day registration?***

Bib pickup and day-of-race registration is on Sand Island in Bethlehem under the Fahy / New Street Bridge. Easy access via steps.



## ***Where do I park?***

[Visit Bethlehem Parking Authority](#) for nearest parking garage or metered parking. No parking on Sand Island due to Celtic Classic.

Parking decks in SouthSide Bethlehem are recommended.

- Riverport Garage, 11 W 2nd St
- New Street Garage, 324 S New St.



## *Where is the finish line?*

The finish line is under the bridge on Sand Island on River Street, same location of bib pickup and registration.



## *Is there a water stop enroute?*

Yes, water is available at approximately 1.5 and 2.5 miles.

Bethlehem Morning Star Rotary volunteers serve water from one location to participants on both the outbound and return legs of the course.

## *What awards will be given?*

1. **Overall Awards** given to the fastest overall male and female runner.
2. **Age Group Awards** given to the top 3 in each age group for both male and female runners.
  - 8 – 14
  - 15 – 19
  - 20 – 29
  - 30 – 39
  - 40 – 49
  - 50 – 59
  - 60 – 69
  - 70 +
3. **Mixed Team/Clan Awards** given to the fastest Mixed Teams/Clans in the 5K.
  - Eligible teams must be a minimum of 3 persons.
  - Each team must include at least 1 “bonnie lassie” (female)
  - Teams may contain more than two (2) members – only top female and top male position will count for the team
  - Team members are still eligible for individual Age Group awards
  - Mixed Team must register with a “team (clan) name”
  - Separate race registration required for each team member; “team name” must be provided at time of registration for each mixed team member
