

Q: Where is Bib Pickup and Race Day Registration?


A: On Sand Island in Bethlehem under the Fahy / New Street Bridge.

A: 10 minutes over the Fahy Bridge.


The red dot at top of map shows Bib Pickup and Race Day Registration location on Sand Island.

E Church St Payrow Plaza Sculpture Lehigh St Center St **Start Line for Celtic Classic 5K** and Celtic Fest Showing the Tartan Parade **Red dot shows Bib Pickup and** (looking north up New Street) Race Day Registration location on Sand Island.

Q: How do we get from Sand Island to the 5K Start Line?


A: Up Sand Island stairs and walk 0.3 miles around City Hall

Green Race Start arrow marks Starting Line for both the Celtic Classic 5K and the Celtic Fest Showing the Tartan Parade.

Celtic Classic 5K is the first entry in the Parade.


At 11:00 AM, 5K participants will move from Sand Island, up the stairs and around City Hall to the start line.

The red line shows the route from Sand Island to the Start Line.




Q: Are there rest rooms?

A: Yes - on Sand Island and PortaPotties at the Start Line.




Q: What is the course for the Celtic Classic 5K?

A: Celtic Classic Parade route to Sand Island and D&L Trail.



Q: How flat or hilly is the Celtic Classic 5K Course Route?
A: Gradual uphill for first quarter mile on New Street, then downhill or flat for remaining 3 miles.



Q: Where is the Celtic Classic 5K Finish Line?

A: On Sand Island at location of Bib Pickup and Registration.

Q: Is there a water stop on Celtic Classic 5K Course Route?

A: Yes, water is available at approximately 1.5 and 2.5 miles.



Bethlehem Morning Star Rotary volunteers serve water from one location to participants on both the outbound and return legs of the course.



Q: Where is the D&L Trail portion of the Celtic Classic 5K Course Route?

A: Almost 2 miles on Sand Island - out to turnaround and back to River St.





Q: Are there turn by turn directions for Celtic Classic 5K?

A: See directions below for Parade Route, Sand Island and D&L Trail.

Q: What does the race to the finish look like?

A: From water stop, on gravel lot and River St – finish under bridge.

Q: What are awards for Celtic Classic 5K?

A: Overall male and female winners receive gift certificates to Aardvark Sports Shop in Bethlehem. Top 3 in age groups receive medals.

Q: What are age groups for Celtic Classic 5K?

A: Medals for top 3 male and female finishers in 12 age groups for both male and female runners up to 70+.
