Families and the organizations that serve them can't always access what's already available.

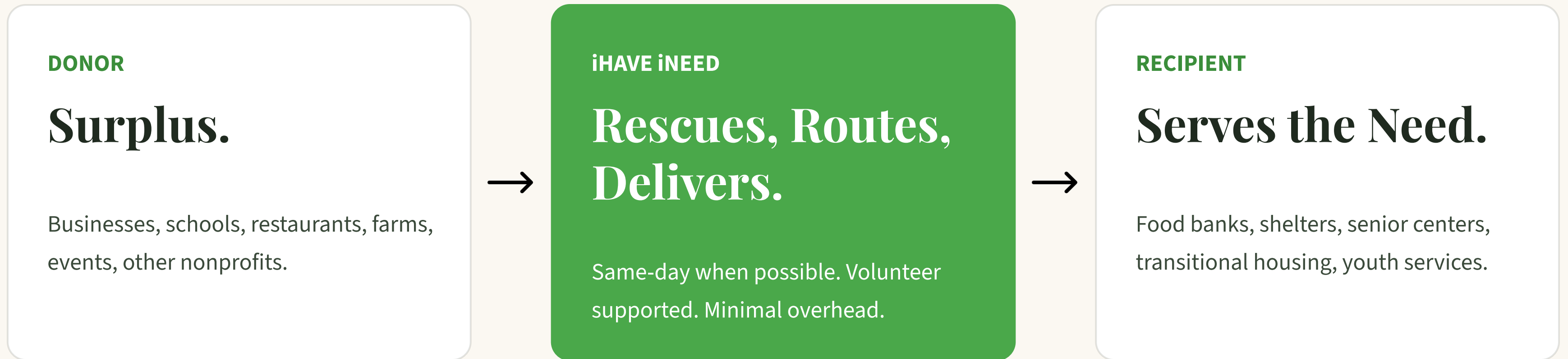
Food banks, shelters, senior centers, youth services — demand keeps rising.

Same-day pickup and drop-off whenever the resources allow.

LEAN

Volunteer-supported and minimal overhead — every pound lands in the community.

DIRECT

Minimal warehouse inventory — most rescues go straight to partner organizations.

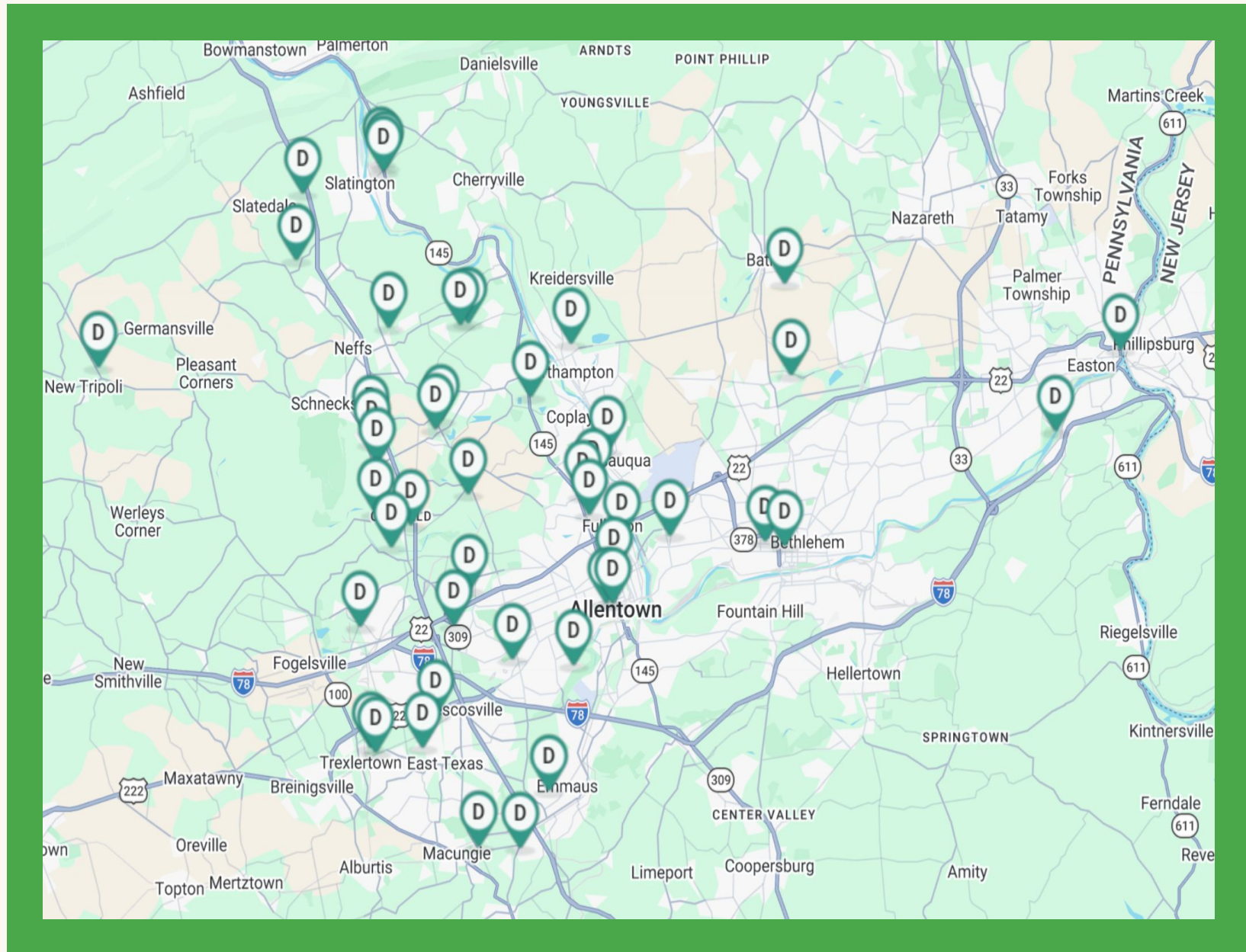

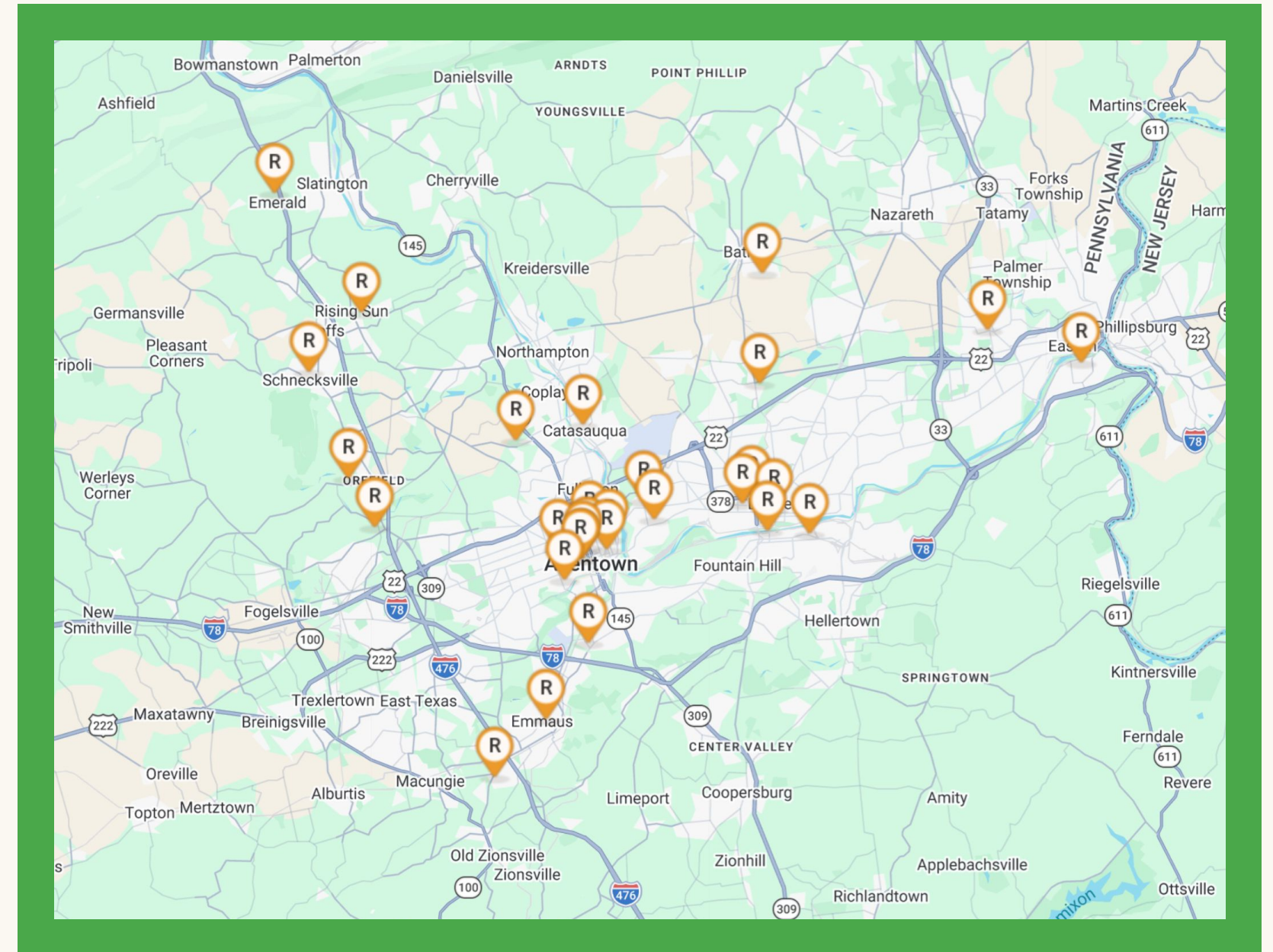

02 Volunteer.

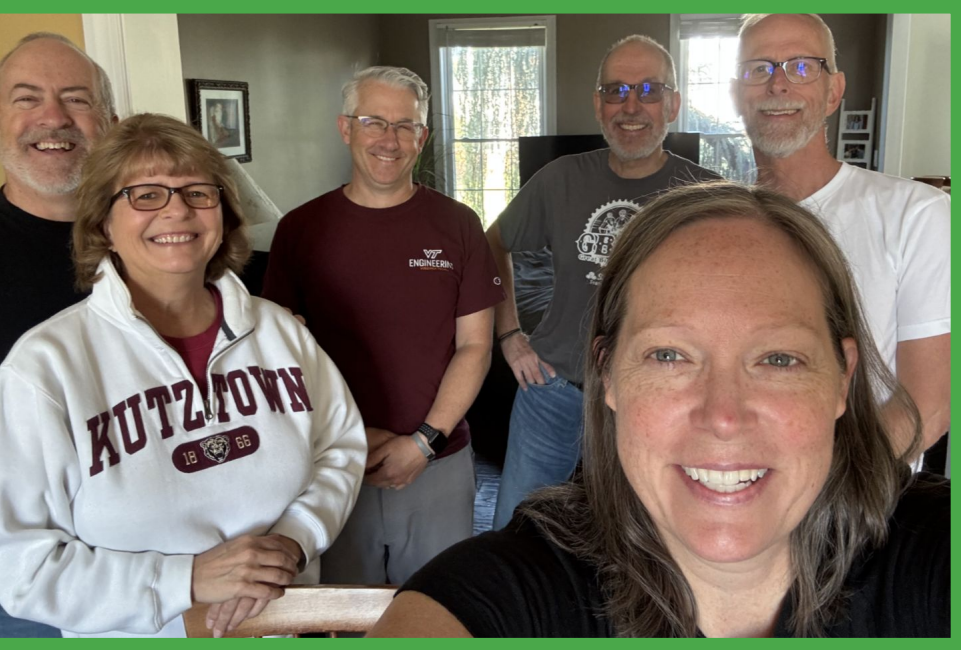
Flexible hours, flexible routes. As
