

DDF Replacement Guidelines

- 1. The donation must be made to The Rotary Foundation Annual Fund (SHARE) and NOT be designated for any specific project.
- 2. The donation must be in addition to any regular donation you make to SHARE. Only the amount which is more than your last year's SHARE donation will be counted. (If you regularly give monthly, and don't change your donation, your entire one-time donation counts.)



DDF Replacement Guidelines

3. You must inform MSR Foundation Chair Susan Burnett, and District GG coordinator Gail Linenberg of the donation, and specifically state that you wish it to be counted as DDF replacement for our project. The easiest way to do that is to make a donation online at my.rotary.org and forward the receipt to Susan and Gail. If you send a check, forward a copy of the check, or the receipt from TRF. Remember to tell us how much of your donation exceeds your regular giving.



DDF Replacement Guidelines

4. Rotarians giving in this way will automatically get Paul Harris and Major Donor credit from TRF, and their Club will get credit towards their Foundation giving goal.
