PHASE 1 - \$15,795

- Repair and replace roof on main classroom building covering 8 classrooms and one office
- Completely repair, plaster, drywall interior walls for 6 classrooms, including new paint
- Repair, level classroom floors, including tile
- Repair, reinforce veranda
- Install new electrical panel, prepare for electric extension to classrooms
- Repair windows, bring up to code
- Exterior paint
- Plant 200 trees for property improvement, shade and erosion prevention

- Complete veranda repair and tile


New Efforts
