Our Results

- 73% of LINC candidates accept jobs after speaking with LINC
 - 52% agree that LINC services were an influencing factor in accepting the job
- 95% of LINC community transition clients agree that LINC made their move to the Lehigh Valley easier, less stressful
- Most partner career clients accept jobs within 4 months of starting services with LINC; 30% faster than the national average


