Rotary International

- 1.4 million Rotarians & Rotaractors in more than 46,000 clubs
- Action plan to support Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI)
- 5 new Rotary Fellowships (90+ total)
- 2 new Rotary Action Groups — the Rotary Action Group for Menstrual Health and Hygiene & the Rotary Action Group for Refugees, Forced Displacement, & Migration (27 total action groups)



Rotary International

- African region free of wild poliovirus
- New area of focus - the environment
- 1,683 global grants awarded (\$47 million from the World Fund, \$120 million in total funding)
- 432 district grants approved (\$31 million in total funding)
- 28 disaster response grants approved (\$688,000 in total funding)
