## Youth Programs

Event	Description
Interact Club	Interact Club is a youth Rotary club at high school level. Our club sponsors a thriving Interact club at Perkiomen Valley HS. We are looking for interested students to reactivate the club at Methacton HS.
Four-Way-Speech Contest	Rotary district wide speech completion that gives high school students to home their opportunity to develop their public speaking skills by delivering speeches on a topic of their choice as it relates to the Rotary Four Way Test. Held each year in March/April.
Camp Neidig	This is a district wide leadership camp to teach rising seniors leadership and team building skills that will last them a life time. Held each June
PVHS Scholarship	We honor a student each year for their accomplishments in community service
Student of the Month	We honor one student each month from Methacton HS and Perkiomen Valley HS. The students are selected by the high school teachers based on their ability to exhibit the traits of the Rotary 4 Way Test.
International Youth Exchange	This program is sponsored globally by Rotary International. For the past 60+ years we have given students (Age 15-19) opportunities to travel to a different country and live with a host family for a full academic year. There are over 4,000 students in this program this year. Our club has a student studying in Argentina during 2017/2018.
Science Fair Awards	Rotary has five "Avenues of Service" ( <a href="https://goo.gl/Am3xoQ">https://goo.gl/Am3xoQ</a> ). We give two awards at the Montgomery County Science Fair for projects that are related to one of these areas of service.
Battle Axe Dinner	There is a long standing tradition and sports rivalry between Methacton HS and Perkiomen Valley HS. We bring the football team seniors and coaches together for a dinner each year before their big game against each other. It is always a fun event.
Scholarships at MCCC	Our club values education and supports local area youth financial support. We have given scholarships at Montgomery County Community College and Ursinus College in the past.

### International

Event	Description
India School Projects	A delegation of 6 members visited India in Jan 2017 with the intent of learning about the country and their needs in education and health. Our club has partnered with a US family to facilitate various projects at schools in India that are in significant need
Belarus Orphanage	Through the dedicated effort of one of our members we provided funding for an orphanage in Belarus to purchase toys for the children
Haiti School Project	Two of our members have traveled to Haiti in the past to provide educational material and training to promote science education in improvised area in Haiti
South Africa – Qumi Home	We partnered with a local organization in South Africa to develop training material for staff at a home for young people with developmental challenges

# Fight Hunger

Event	Description
Daily Bread Food Pantry	Hunger continues to be a big challenge for many families in our community. This food pantry has been in operation for many years to satisfy some of the needs. We sponsor various events to raise funds for this food pantry ( <a href="http://dailybreadcommunityfoodpantry.org/">http://dailybreadcommunityfoodpantry.org/</a> )
Holiday Food Baskets	During the holiday season each year, we assemble baskets of food to prepare a traditional meal for the whole family and provide to families in need through the food pantry. During 2017, we partnered with the local area Boy Scout Troop to purchase the items and prepare the baskets
Food Packing / Potato Planting	Members of our club have participated in several events to package nutritionally balanced food that is delivered to local food pantries and sent internationally to feed the poor. We have also helped another club in our district that grows potatoes that are supplied to the area food pantries
Phillies Strike Our Hunger	This is an annual food drive to collect food and provide it to local area food pantries
Back Pack Programs	Our local area schools have many students that rely on state subsidized meal programs at the school. Many of them go hungry during the weekends. This program gives these students a bag of ready to eat food that can be used during the weekends. We provided funding to start this program at two of the Methacton Elementary Schools

Perkiomen Creek Clean-up	Many of our club members are volunteering to support the the Perkiomen Valley Watershed Conservancy's annual event to clean the local creek banks of trash and debris that have collected through the year ( <a href="https://www.perkiomenwatershed.org/">https://www.perkiomenwatershed.org/</a> )
Tree Planting	Our Rotary International president has challenged all 1.2 million members to plant at least one tree this year. Our club will be taking part in this challenge. We have also participated in other tree planting initiatives in the past.
Route 29 Clean-up	Our club participates in local area clean up efforts to keep our environment free of debris
