

## HEALTH & SAFETY REGULATIONS FOR LANSDALE DAY 2021

Anyone attending Lansdale Day must adhere to the safety guidelines set forth by the CDC and PA Health Department as well as any rules set by local county and borough health and safety officials. The following rules must be adhered to while attending Lansdale Day 2021:

1. We ask that anyone who is feeling ill, has a fever, or is exhibiting even mild symptoms to REMAIN HOME AND NOT ATTEND THIS EVENT. **For the Health and Safety of everyone**, please do not attend if you have a temperature greater than 98.9 and/or if you are exhibiting any signs or symptoms such as shortness of breath, cough, runny nose, fever, loss of taste/smell., etc. PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE TO OTHERS AND FOLLOW THESE HEALTH & SAFETY RULES
2. A face covering (ie: mask, face shield) must be constantly worn, covering both nose and mouth, while attending any part of Lansdale Day 2021. This applies to the general public attending the event as well as the vendors and volunteer staff. The only exceptions are as follows:
  - a. Children under the age of 2 are not required to wear a face covering
  - b. Those with disabilities or medical conditions that hinder proper breathing
  - c. Face covering can be removed for eating in designated food court areas only
3. Hand sanitizer will be provided at each and every pre-approved vendor space for the general public to use. Hand Sanitizer will be provided in each of the three portable restrooms and on the designated food court area tables.
4. Food Vendors will monitor any line forming of people waiting to be served and ask that all who are in these lines to maintain a 6' distance between patrons.
5. While walking around Lansdale Day, observance of 6' between non-family members is required.
6. Vendors will not allow more than 1-2 patrons within their booth space at a time. Patrons are asked to limit their time within a vendor's booth space to under 15 minutes and to use hand sanitizer prior to touching any items on display.
7. The Event Host (Rotary Club of North Penn) will be making constant announcements via the Public Address System reminding all who attend to wear a face covering and practice social distancing while enjoying the fun at Lansdale Day 2021.
8. All pre-approved vendors attending Lansdale Day will be screened at vendor-check in. For a comprehensive outline of this screening, please view the Vendor Safety Agreement posted on our website.
9. There will be a limited number of tables and chairs located in designated eating areas. These items will be frequently cleaned and disinfected throughout the day. Hand sanitizer will be provided at each table.
10. After arriving to the event, we ask anyone feeling ill to please inform the Safety Officer at the Rotary Club of North Penn's booth space. This will be located at the corner of Main & Wood Streets (near Stove & Tap)
