2020-2021 Training Grants

The Rotary Club of Damariscotta-Newcastle offers Training Grants to people who live or work in Lincoln County and seek financial help to acquire or upgrade skills to advance in their chosen vocation. A Grant may be awarded for either:

- * a skills training program that leads to some form of license, certification or degree
- or
- * purchase of tools and equipment needed for professional work

The Grants can cover up to 90% of the cost of tuition/fees or tools, and are paid to the program upon proof of acceptance to the program, or the submission of receipts for tools. Other payment arrangements are at the discretion of the Training Grants Committee. Applicants may be of any age, and diverse vocations are welcome. Applicants must meet any requirements of the desired training program.

Application Procedure

You may submit an application for a Training Grant at any time throughout the year, but it should be at least eight (8) weeks in advance of the training program's start date. We review applications monthly. To apply, fill out either the Training Grant Application form or the Tools Grant Application form and submit using one of these two options (the first option is preferred but not required).
