



Rotary Club of Damariscotta-Newcastle 2018 Grants and Scholarships

General

- Application deadline is April 6, 2018, by post office or email.
- Finalists may be asked to participate in a personal interview with members of the local Rotary Club Scholarship Committee.
- For the two grant categories, diverse vocations are welcome—examples include mechanics, building trades, nursing, personal care, art, and business.
- Applicants must choose one of the following three categories.

Applied Technology Grant

- Intended for expenses of attending vocational, community, and two-year colleges, and continuing professional education.
- Up to five grants, ranging from \$1000 to \$3000, at discretion of Scholarship Committee.
- Recommendations and written plan are required.

David McLeod “Service Above Self” Scholarship

- Intended for expenses of attending traditional four-year college.
- One \$4000 award.
- Looking for strong community or family service experience.
- Academic records, recommendations, and essay are required.

Tools of the Trade Grant

- Intended for the purchase of tools needed for professional work, or to support further training and preparation for the recipient’s chosen vocation.
- Tools can be anything of a durable nature that one must own for work.
- Training and preparation can include certification, licensing, permitting, and the like.
- One grant of up to \$1000.
- Recommendations and written plan are required.
