Guest Speaker: Rotarian Steve Puderbaugh: Membership

Steve grew up in Des Moines, Iowa and attended Iowa State University where he obtained his BS degree and then his Doctor of Veterinary Medicine. Steve practiced in Iowa and Massachusetts. He and his wife, Deb founded Raymond Animal Hospital in 1985 and retired in 2022.

Steve was a charter member of The Rotary Club of Raymond and has held numerous leadership positions in Rotary including Assistant Governor, District Foundation Chair, Group Study Exchange chair and team leader for an Australian exchange, and District 7870 Governor in 2020-21. Steve is currently serving as membership chair for a new satellite club in Northwood, NH and is now the Rotary Zone Coordinator for Membership. Steve is a Paul Harris Fellow and received Rotary foundation's Citation for Meritorious Service.

Steve presented Membership recruitment ideas and tips which would help our club expand and develop our memberships. He suggested the fastest way for anyone to get involved in a community is to join Rotary and recommended using that approach with prospective members. He suggested gathering historical information on our club's achievements that could be shared to expand our reach in the community.

be concerned about attrition. He shared statistics regarding attrition rates for Rotary in the US and in our club. While we have attracted new members at a higher rate than the average, we have also lost members through attrition at a higher rate.

Steve shared two videos with us including "Rotary, the Road to Growth" and "Membership, Adapt and Embrace Change". He also cited the August *Rotarian* article, "What Members Want". Steve suggested regular club health checks and surveys asking members for feedback and ideas.

In summation, Steve recommended clubs become agile and active. People join after they receive personal invitations and inviting them to service projects or events is often better than an invitation to a club meeting. He recommended developing strategies and reminded us that hope is not a strategy.
