Program: Official District Governor Visit

Asst. Gov. Gary Branyen introduced District 7780 Governor Bob MacKenzie and welcomed him for his official visit to our club. Bob is a long-term member of Kennebunk Rotary Club and has served as the Chief of Police in Kennebunk since 2008. He is a graduate of the FBI National Academy, served Kennebunk Rotary as President and is the Chair of the District 7780 Recovery Initiative.

Bob thanked the club for its support as he entered his year as District Governor and thanked past District Governor Marion for service and guidance as he has moved through the Governor's track for the district. Bob started by sharing with the club a shirt that his club gave him with the many faces and roles he has taken on over the years and proudly wore the shirt throughout his presentation.

Bob spoke of his work on the Recovery Initiative and the importance of addressing addiction and the opioid crisis in Maine and New Hampshire. He relayed personal stories regarding how the issue has impacted his family and the

journeys of his children and stepchildren. Recovery continues to be a focus for his family, and he has served to come together and live healthy lives.

Bob identified the opioid epidemic as something we need to educate our communities about. To that end, District 7780 will be presenting the Third Annual Recovery Conference, Critical Partners: Mental Health and The Road to Recovery. Bob identified the efforts regarding mental health and the Rotary Action Group initiated by Marion as important work that will continue
