Program: Southern New Hampshire Ukulele Group (SNHUG)

Kathy F. welcomed June, Tom and Jeannie from the Southern New Hampshire Ukulele Group. June showed a brief PowerPoint about the history and purpose of the group: a forum for area uke-sters (some 600 members!) to share music, learn ukulele-playing, and have fun.

They also fucus on community service, playing concerts at schools, nursing homes, and hospitals. S.N.H.U.G. has raised, to date, over \$93,000 for charity, mainly the Ukulele Kids' Club, which provides instruments and instruction in pediatric wards.

Their two big fund-raising events are their Luau (April 22) in Brentwood and the SNHUGFest (September 16) at Henry Law Park. SNHUGFest currently holds the record---161---for most ukuleles playing on one stage. The group meets bi-weekly on Friday evenings in Brentwood from 6-8pm to practice and play together.

Tom and Jennie passed out ukuleles to each Rotary member and, with their guidance, we learned two chords and played rousing renditions of "Singin' in the Rain" and "My Darlin' Clementine".

Elvis even appeared to perform "Hound Dog" with June and Jennie!
