Paul Jenkins, described by Nick P. as an "all around good guy", led the conversation about the upcoming Seacoast Cancer 10th Annual 5K from his perspective as a prosthetist – a health professional that designs, builds and fits artificial limbs for people with disabilities.

One of his patients was a young boy who had an ill-fitting prosthesis that kept him reliant on a wheelchair. He came to Paul for help and they ended up helping each other. After spending



time talking with the boy, Paul fitted him correctly so he could walk, then convinced the young guy to enter the 2019 SC5K road race. Paul walked beside the boy for one

mile – a huge accomplishment for someone reliant on a wheelchair and both have participated ever since. They formed Team Awesome and so far 74

people have joined along with thousands of other racers to raise money for patients in the Mass General Cancer Center at Wentworth-Douglass Hospital. Arul Mahadevan, MD is a Radiation Oncologist and Service Line Medical Director for the Mass General Cancer Center at WDH. While the name is new (previously Seacoast Cancer Center), he assured all the high level of care continues with wider capabilities and now in two locations – Dover and Portsmouth (Pease). As an example, Dr. Mahadevan noted Mass General Clinical Trials will now be offered locally for patients with advanced cancers. This year's SC5K will continue to support patients needing services not covered by insurance, such as diet counseling, caregiver support and transportation. There are several opportunities to sponsor and participate. On Aug. 21 there will be a Rally for the Run at Dover to celebrate caregivers and survivors. Race Day is Sept. 24, 2023.
