



Vocational Training & Tools Grant

The Rotary Club of Dover, NH offers Vocational Training & Tools financial assistance grant for individuals who live or work in Dover, NH to acquire or upgrade skills in their chosen field of expertise to:

- Support career success and meet employer needs
- Expand the community's workforce
- Increase available services in Strafford County

Grants may be awarded for one of the following: Training resulting in a license, certification or associate degree in a vocational program or for the purchase of tools and/or necessary equipment to continue in the vocation of choice.

Grants may cover up to 80% of the cost of tuition/fees or tools and are paid to the individual upon proof of acceptance to the program, or the submission of receipt(s) for tools. Other payment arrangements are at the discretion of the VT&T Grant Committee. Applications are accepted without regard to age, race, gender, sexual orientation or any disability. Applicants must meet requirements of the desired training program.

Note: Grants do not cover 4-year college programs. The Rotary Club of Dover, NH offers Rotary Scholarships for Dover students entering a 4-year program. Contact school counselors in the Spring of the academic year for applications.

Application Process

Applications for a VT&T Grant are reviewed monthly and may be submitted at any time during the year but should be at least six (6) weeks in advance of the training program's start.

The committee reserves the right to interview or request more information as it sees fit. Both recipients and the program teacher/administrator will be notified when the grant is approved

Follow-up

The grant recipient is required to give the Grants Committee documentation of the earned certificate, license, or associate degree.

A year after participating in a training program or obtaining tools, a member of the VT&T Grants Committee will contact recipients for a brief follow-up and suggestions to improve the Grants program. Grant recipients may be announced in a press release and invited to be a guest at a Rotary Club meeting to share experiences (attendance is not required to receive a grant). Photos may be taken at the meeting.
