Last Week:

We finally had the opportunity to present the Rowe School food pantry with our \$500 donation from our road toll for the food pantries last fall. Heidi Darling heads up the pantry and with the help of Marissa Rivers and Austin Fox talked about the pantry. The pantry serves about 20 students on a regular basis every week. They also pack food for weekends and vacations because many of the students only get food through the school. They are looking for easy to prepare foods such as soups, canned vegetables and mac & cheese. There is also a need for personal hygiene items – deodorant, tooth brushes, tooth paste and so on.

Rebecca Powell, with assistance from Emily Cummings, talked about the Walking School Bus. This program started in October 2014 when the school district received a grant to get kids walking to school safely instead of taking a bus. The grant was for a stipend to pay for a coordinator. Right now, there are 40 kids that participate, starting off at Ari's every school morning at 8:00AM and then winding through the village to Rowe School. The kids are met at their homes in the morning and dropped off in the afternoon. They walk regardless of the weather. Lots of volunteers are needed as there needs to be one adult for every 10 kids. If you want to volunteer, see Mr. Hart or Mrs. Powell at Rowe School for an application. It is also important to note that the grant runs out in November of this year and funding is not available through the district, so they are looking for donations and funding to keep the program going.
