For her Rotary Moment, <u>**Treasurer Liz</u>** talked about the International Convention taking place in Calgary, Alberta, Canada from the $21^{st} - 25^{th}$ of June. According to the info in the Rotary magazine, there will be 440 ethnic groups speaking 165 different languages at the convention. She also talked about the National Cocktail of Canada, called the Caesar. It is a variation of a Bloody Mary consisting of vodka, Clamato juice, hot sauce and Worcestershire sauce, served in a large, salted rimmed glass typically garnished with a celery stalk and a wedge of lime. It is typically unheard of outside of Canada.</u>
