<u>President Chris</u>, with the assistance of sponsor <u>Patty Rice</u>, inducted <u>Davin Currie</u> as our newest member. Davin is the son of charter member Scott Currie. Our guest speaker was *Sal Girifalco, President of the Lakes Association of Norway.* The Lakes Association covers all of the lakes and ponds in Norway, not just Pennesseewassee. The Association is working in a number of areas to preserve water quality in the lakes. Two areas the Association is working on are invasive plants, in particular mil- foil, and phosphorus pollution which promotes algae growth. The Association is working on solutions now before these issues become major issues in the future. They have been doing a lot of tests on water quality and boat inspections, concentrating on prevention. All it takes is one seed on the bottom of a boat or a propeller to bring in an infestation of milfoil. Phosphorus is also a major problem with run off from lawns along the lake shores. They ae going to be doing a watershed survey, looking for places where phosphorus can enter the lake. Sal gave a very interesting and informative talk.
