**Portsmouth Rotary-100 Committee Scope:**

**PRC-100 is a yearlong Centennial initiative that this committee is tasked with defining, coordinating, leading and delivering, with the following goals:**

- 1. The Club will articulate and embrace a forward-looking 100-year vision of PRC's future.**
- 2. Engagement by Rotarians: our goal is that 100% of Portsmouth Rotary Club members and Portsmouth Interact members will participate in one or more of the PRC100 year-long activities, with active member engagement and club fellowship opportunities.**
- 3. Deliver a meaningful PRC100 Centennial project/donation to the community with lasting Rotary visibility.**
- 4. Produce at least one PRC100 signature Centennial event(s)**
- 5. Create at least one memento of PRC100 for lasting visibility.**
- 6. Execute one or more companion fundraising campaigns to deliver PRC-100 goals.**
- 7. Seek partnership with Portsmouth-400 committee and other community organizations.**
