

GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION FOR THE



SANFORD-SPRINGVALE ROTARY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Sanford-Springvale Rotary Club will award scholarships totaling a minimum of \$15,000 this year to graduating seniors from Sanford High School, Massabesic High School, Noble High School and Sanford Regional Technical Center (SRTC).

Scholarships will be awarded based on the availability of funds.

Criteria

1. Any graduating senior from Sanford High School, Massabesic High School, Noble High School and the Sanford Regional Technical Center (SRTC) are eligible to apply with one exception: a child or grandchild of a member of the Sanford-Springvale Rotary Club is not eligible.
2. Students will be selected by the scholarship committee of the Sanford-Springvale Rotary Club.
3. The scholarship committee of the Sanford-Springvale Rotary Club will review all applications. Semi-finalists will be called for personal interviews early in May. Awards will be announced during a breakfast hosted by the Rotary Club.
4. Awards will be paid in two equal installments: the first, at the beginning of the first semester and the second at the beginning of the second semester. Evidence of satisfactory completion of the first semester must be furnished to the Sanford-Springvale Rotary Club before the second installment is paid.
5. The scholarship committee will consider scholarship, financial need, intended course of study, citizenship, extra-curricular and outside interests, and other pertinent data with particular attention paid to the number of hours and the nature of service to the community, as well as the content of the essay (See #9)
6. Applications must be TYPED or neatly printed and must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee of the Sanford-Springvale Rotary Club no later than April 8th.
7. A student aid report from FAFSA is required with the scholarship submission, as this is a transcript of the student's grades. In addition, please provide a complete list of your Volunteer Hours showing what organizations, as well as what tasks you performed.
8. The topic of this year's essay is the **FOUR-WAY TEST** of Rotary International:
 - a. Is it the TRUTH?
 - b. Is it FAIR to all concerned?
 - c. Will it build GOOD WILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
 - d. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?
