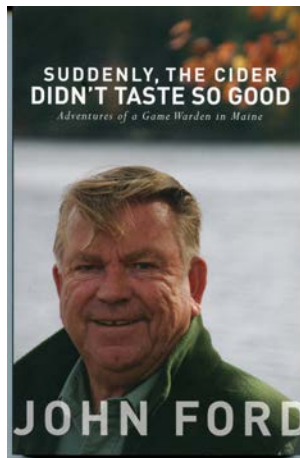

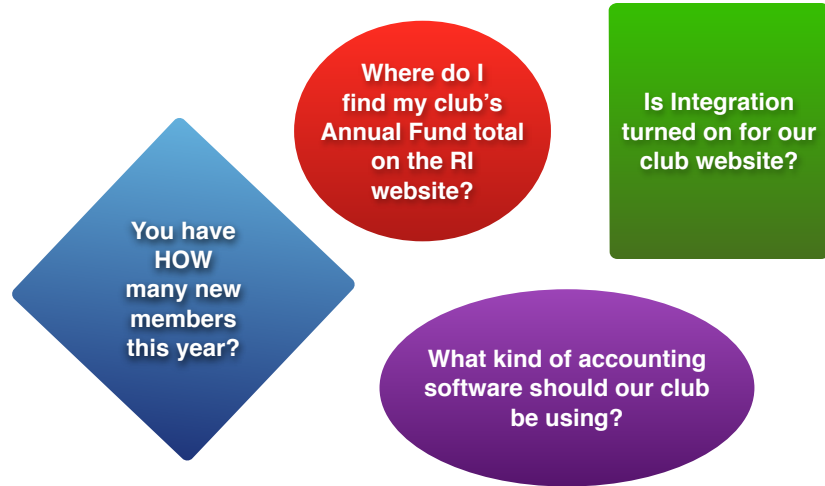

2014 India Water Project

This year, we gathered a team of about 29 Rotarians from France, Germany, Switzerland, Ireland, Canada (including the Yukon Territory) USA (from Michigan, New York, Pennsylvania, California and Maine). In addition, about a dozen Rotarians and some spouses from the Rotary Club of Delhi - Megapolis joined in the construction of the dam. This is one of the largest dams to be constructed under the program, in conjunction with the India Rotary Water Conservation Trust, headed by past Rotary International Director, Sushil Gupta of Delhi, India. The dam will stretch across approximately 330 feet, and, when completed, will hold back water from the monsoons which will cover approximately 100 square kilometers! The team worked for four days and most likely, at the end of May of 2014, the dam will be completed.

Did you know?

Rotary members worldwide celebrated a major milestone in the global effort to eradicate polio: India, until recently an epicenter of the wild poliovirus, marked the third anniversary of its last recorded case of the disease on January 13th of this year.
