



**EAST LONGMEADOW ROTARY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION
INCORPORATED (ELRMSFI) AND EAST LONGMEADOW ROTARY FOUNDATION
INCORPORATED (ELRFI) SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Every year, ELRMSFI AND ELRFI awards numerous scholarships to high school seniors who are college bound or vocational students.

- **High school seniors or technical/vocational students who are residents of East Longmeadow** are eligible to apply for **any** of the scholarships (this includes students from schools outside of the town).
- For the Douglas Burack Culinary Arts Scholarship, those already attending training/college are eligible to apply if they are East Longmeadow residents.
- Children and grandchildren of East Longmeadow Rotarians are eligible to apply for the scholarships even if the child or grandchild does not reside in East Longmeadow.

A total of \$20,000 in scholarships was awarded between ELRMSFI and ELRFI in 2017.

- Since its inception in 1986, the ELRMSFI has awarded \$328,750 in scholarships. Since 1993, the ELRFI has awarded \$40,250 in scholarships.

The following details the amounts for the scholarships awarded in 2017 and the description of the scholarships.

For 2018, the following scholarships are being offered:

- The Earl MacDonald Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of Earl MacDonald who was an East Longmeadow Rotarian with generous contributions by his family. **Amount for 2018 = one scholarship for \$3000.**
- The James Davis Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of James Davis, Founder of the former American Saw and Manufacturing Company. **Amount for 2018 = two scholarships for \$1500 each.**
- The Douglas Burack Memorial Scholarships: Given in memory of East Longmeadow Rotarian Dan Burack's son. Doug was a student at Johnson and Wales prior to his death. The scholarships are awarded to East Longmeadow High School seniors or post-secondary students enrolled/enrolling in Culinary Arts or related field. If no Culinary Art students apply, the scholarships can be awarded to students pursuing technical training or a business degree. **Amount for 2018 = two scholarships for \$2000 each.**
- The Jean Ference-Burack Memorial Scholarship: Given in memory of Rotarian Dan Burack's late wife who was deeply involved in community service in East Longmeadow. These scholarships are awarded to high school seniors who demonstrated a **strong history of service to our community**. **Amount for 2018 = two scholarships for \$2000 each.**
- The Michael Linnehan Memorial Scholarship: Awarded in memory of East Longmeadow Rotarian Michael Linnehan who was a past club President, ELRMSFI and Scholarship Committee member. **Amount for 2018 = one scholarship for \$1000.**
- ELRMSFI Scholarship: Awarded based on merit to a deserving student. **Amount for 2018 = one scholarship for \$2000.**
- ELRFI Scholarship: Awarded based on merit to a deserving student. **Amount for 2018 = one scholarship for \$2000.**



- **Willie Ferrero Scholarship:** Awarded in memory of Willie Ferrero, the founder of the East Longmeadow Rotary Summer Concert Series to a student attending college pursuing a degree/training in the music or entertainment industry. If no applicant for the music or entertainment industry, the scholarship is awarded based on merit. ***Amount for 2018 = one scholarship for \$2000.***

Each application will be reviewed by the East Longmeadow Rotary Club Scholarship Committee and scored on the following criteria:

1. **Academic Record:** Official School Transcript of Grades, SAT Score Report and Class Standing (SAT score and Class Standing must be requested specifically from the school by the student and included in the application)
2. **School Contributions:** Club membership, Athletics and School Activity Involvement
3. **Community Contributions:** Community Service that extends to the students community outside of the school
4. **Essay about future college plans and career goals.** Described how further education will aid in fulfilling those goals.
5. **Letters of recommendations:** Three letters of recommendations are required. At least one of the letters must be from the student's advisor or teacher.
6. Applications must meet eligibility criteria (above).

Scholarship recipients are required to certify in writing that the scholarship award will be used for educational purposes.

The suspense date for application receipt is February 24, 2018. No applications will be accepted after that date. Please mail the applications and documents to East Longmeadow Rotary Club 6530, c/o Scholarship Committee, PO Box 571, East Longmeadow MA 01028. Please ensure that all attached documents are legible (see checklist).

A lunchtime East Longmeadow Rotary Club meeting is scheduled to honor all the scholarship recipients on **May 31, 2018**. Recipients are expected to attend unless extenuating circumstances prevail. Parents are welcome to join their scholar at the luncheon meeting.

 4. Essay (500 words) - Explain how college, technical or vocational education will help you fulfill your career plans and goals.
- Official School Transcript of Grades
- SAT Score Report
- Class Standing Information
- Three Letters of Recommendation – Don’t wait to ask for the letters!
