Since 1979, Rotary members have persevered in the fight to eradicate polio. On August 25, 2020, Rotary reached a historical and vital step toward global eradication of polio. Transmission of the wild poliovirus has officially been stopped in all 47 countries of the African region!

Last year, the East Longmeadow Rotary Club hosted an awareness seminar about human trafficking. Other community events we organized included Celebrate East Longmeadow and Day of Service. This year, thanks to generous community donations, we were able to build a new band shell, that will premier at our 2024 Concert Series.

Rotary is a volunteer organization with over 1.2 million global members in over 35,000 worldwide clubs. Members volunteer over 16 million hours per year. The Rotary Club of East Longmeadow was chartered in 1970 and just celebrated its 56th Charter Night in June 2026. Rotarians are volunteer members of member clubs united under the global organization of Rotary International. As of May 2026, 1.2 million neighbors, friends, leaders, and problem-solvers who see a world where people unite in over 46,000 clubs across over 200 countries around the world. Rotarians take action to create lasting change – across the globe, in our communities, and in ourselves following the motto "Service Above Self".

The three main components of Rotary are: Clubs, Rotary International and The Rotary Foundation. The grassroots Club level is the operational heart of Rotary where member volunteer and run local service projects. Each Club has elected officers and board members to oversee operations, committees and service.

The global organization of Rotary International that set policy, provides resources and supports clubs. The charitable arm of The Rotary Foundation that funds programs like PolioPlus and the Annual Fund toward grants and projects.

The East Longmeadow Rotary Foundation Inc. is a 501C3 charitable foundation that raises funds for philanthropic projects locally, nationally and internationally. Over the past five decades, the Rotarians of East Longmeadow have raised money from concerts, community events, t-shirt and hat sales, Celebrity Bartending events and other 'sweat equity' sources to contribute to communities near and far through multiple projects. 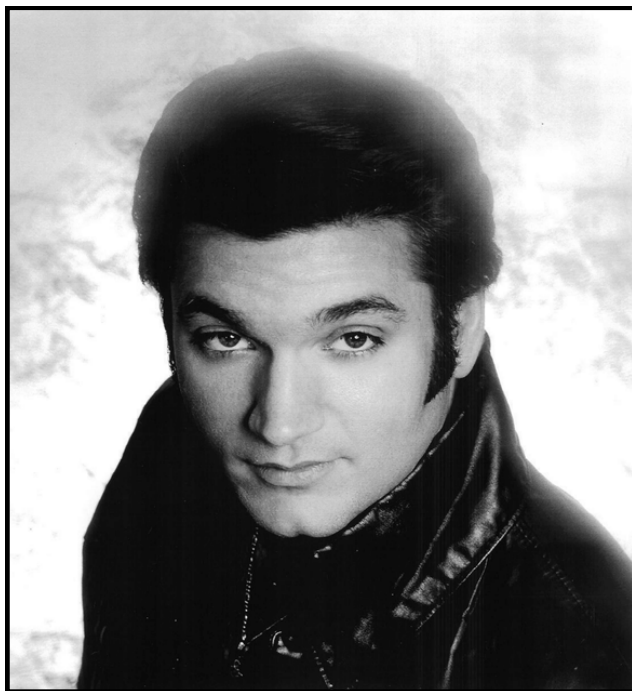

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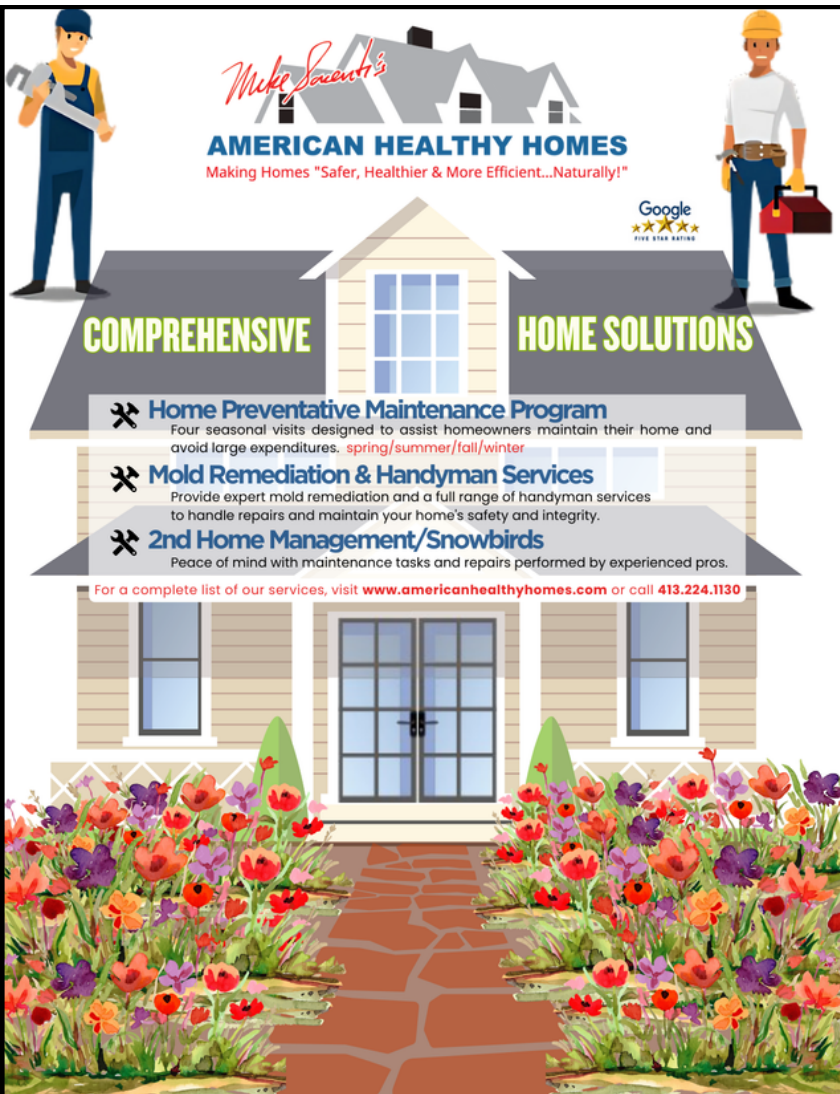

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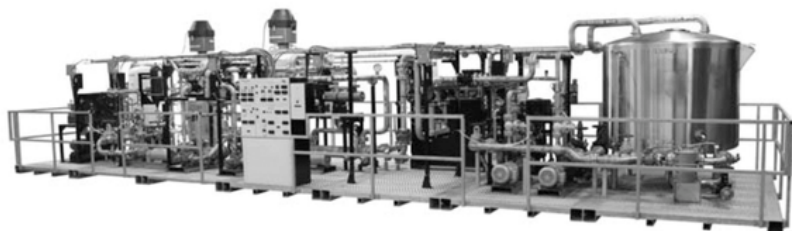

In 2006, the band recorded a 5-track EP titled "Let's Go" which led to nominations as the area's "Best New Band" and "Best Rock Band" followed shortly after the success of the independently recorded and released EP.

In 2010, the band recording a full length album "Heat". Recorded at The Rotary Records in Western Massachusetts, the album was highly regarded by the New England music scene and musical critics. In the purest form, the band's songs from "Heat" began with a pen, paper and an acoustic guitar. The songs then developed and rose to the anthemic rock sound Pridefalls has become known for.
