#### APPLICATION CRITERIA INCLUDES:

- Watertown / Oakville resident
- Cannot be the child or grandchild of a Rotary member
- Financial need based on FAFSA Information
- Attending Full Time a college/university
- Student Personal Essay as defined in this application
- Scholastic record and SAT scores {Applications will not be considered without SAT Scores}
- Two (2) Recommendations from Teacher, Guidance Counselor, Internships or Community Services

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

- The Rotary Club of Watertown must receive scholarship applications by March 21st. Applications received after this
  date will not be considered
- Complete all sections of the application. Applications that are incomplete will not be considered
- APPLICATIONS:
  - o Watertown High School: All applications must be submitted through the student's high school guidance office who will forward to the Watertown Rotary Club along with SAT scores, essay, school transcript and recommendations
  - o Watertown/Oakville Students not attending Watertown High School: All applications must be mailed to the Watertown Rotary Club along with SAT scores, essay, school transcript and recommendations
- A copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR) showing Expected Family Contribution (EFC) must be sent directly to the
