In 2026, Rotary will have three competitive grant deadlines. The grant committee will meet following the conclusion of each round to determine grant awards. Applicants will be notified via email regarding the status of their application.

Round 1: Open January 16, 2026 – February 13, 2026

Round 2: Open April 6, 2026 – May 8, 2026

Round 3: Open October 1, 2026 – November 1, 2026.

- Literacy
- Community Wellness and Mental Health
