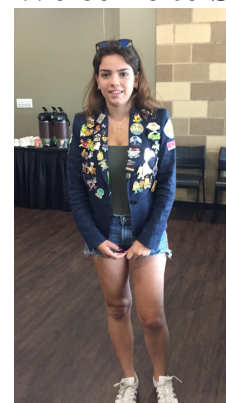

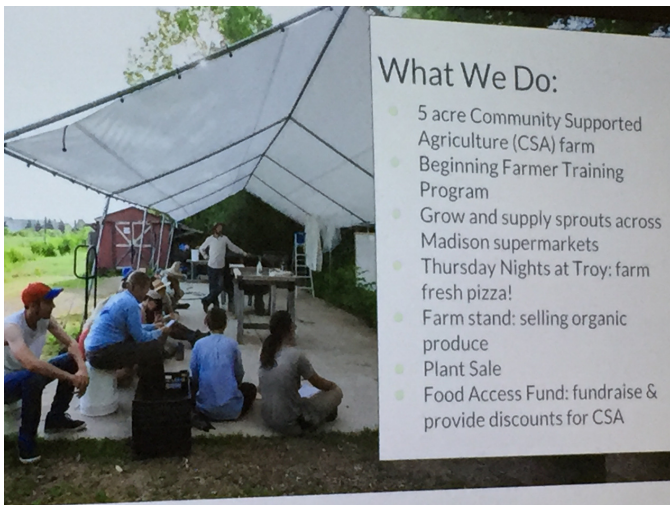


The club's 2018-19 exchange
