July Report

We had one book packing event in July with employees of Park Bank. Six pallets were completed.

We shipped one load with 27 pallets of books and 56 desks. Desks were donated last month by the Deforest School District with the help of the Deforest Rotary Club.

We continue receiving lots of books from schools. A total of 785 boxes were donated. This is the second largest month of donations this year.

86 volunteers donated 192 total hours during the month of June. This includes book pick-ups and deliveries, packing books, loading the truck and other miscellaneous activities.

We have worked our backlog of books that are ready to ship down to 24 pallets. However we now have 60 pallets of books that need to be packed!

Other Activities: Through our social media campaign, grants and other donations, we now have over \$10,000 in our account, enough to ship the next five truck-loads of books. Huge thanks to all who have contributed to this effort.

Future Activities: We have five book packing events scheduled for August. Three of these are with the United Way Days of Caring
