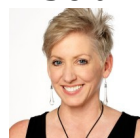

Rotarian of the Year Gary Muldoon

At a festive club party on August 26 held at the Capital Brewery, Kevin Frost presented Gary Muldoon

He started with saying "yes" to taking on a grant project for a new library wing to a community center in Kongoni, Kenya. Last year, he said "yes" to taking the reigns of our partnership with Los Altos in Guatemala, turning what started as one international project into two more, which will help directly advance the education of Guatemalan children with new books, desks, and chairs. He also said "yes" to taking the leadership of a team replacing Thom Weiss's position for leading the Wisconsin chapter for Books for the World, which enables many clubs in the Madison area and beyond to get educational resources to communities that need them. And he's said yes to being the new "club co-president" for the upcoming year.

Gary Muldoon Also Awarded District Avenue of International Service Award

Erin Hastey, past club president, presented Gary Muldoon with the District Avenue of Service award for his international work. She said that Gary led the effort to earn a district grant to help add a library wing to the community center in Kongoni, Kenya. In addition to taking on a leadership role of the Wisconsin Chapter of Books for the World, he has fostered an outstanding relationship with our global grant partner, Rotario Los Altos in Guatemala. In addition to concluding our global grant project to install a water line to a rural village, Gary has led us explore other areas of partnership with the club to build and supply library modules that will be given to schools in rural parts of Guatemala.
