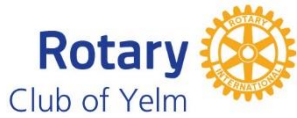


Announcing Application for the

Elementary school teachers located within the Yelm Community School District are eligible to apply for a one-time Mini-Grant offered by the Rotary Club of Yelm. Mini-Grants are awarded up to \$500, for classroom materials or programs that would otherwise be unfunded. Our goal is to encourage and aid in adding more literacy projects into the classroom. Teachers must request grants individually. A teacher may apply for one (1) mini-grant per year; an individual teacher may receive no more than one (1) mini-grant per year.
