

2021-2022 ANNUAL COMMUNITY GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS

To be considered for a Rotary Club of San Leandro (RCSL) Community Grant, please submit the grant application by email no later than **5:00 p.m. on February 25, 2022**. If submitted after the deadline, your application will be considered **only** if there are remaining funds for the 2021/2022 grant making year.

2021/2022 Grant Priority Areas:

- San Leandro based, majority (51%) of clients served are San Leandro residents. Any exceptions to this will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and will be presented, with sufficient rationale, to the Board if awards will be made/proposed.
- Focused on programs/activities with most benefit to individuals, no "cosmetic" capital projects (painting, flooring etc.)
- Focus populations: Children and families, seniors, "At-Risk" individuals
- Priorities can change each year based on committee recommendations to the Board

Required elements of the grant:

- A press release of the joint partnership between your non-profit and The Rotary Club of San Leandro.
- If you have a website, a link to our website to show our local projects and/or through other social media outlets.
- A Rotary presence to assist/volunteer with your projects (if applicable and as outlined in your grant application).
- It is customary that all checks are distributed at one of the weekly luncheon meetings held by the Rotary Club of San Leandro. Due to COVID restrictions, other arrangements may be made to receive checks. Grant awardees will be asked to attend a meeting (virtual or in-person) to do a short presentation related to the award.

The Rotary Club of San Leandro will inform you by the end of March, 2022 on the status of your grant request. Partial funding may be presented as alternative awards.

- 1. Detailed budget of your proposed project or new program
- 2. Organization's latest Balance Sheet
- 3. List of officers and directors of the organization and their affiliations
