Today's Speaker

R. Adm. Larry R. Marsh Olmsted Scholar Program

This morning we welcome Rear Admiral Larry Roy Marsh, USN (Ret.). Following 35 years of active Navy service, Admiral Marsh joined The George and Carol Olmsted Foundation in 1999 and has served as president since 2002.

Admiral Marsh graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy in 1963,

and was selected as an Olmsted Scholar himself in 1967. This enabled him to undertake postgraduate studies at The American University in Washington and the University of Munich.

Admiral Marsh served on five submarines including the USS Will Rogers, which he commanded from July 1977 to March 1981. He went on to hold numerous senior-level command and staff positions, retiring as Deputy Chief of Naval Personnel in 1998.

Running on Empty

Our own Hunter Herron, Ph.D., offered a sobering appraisal of the world's oil resources at our May 12 meeting: While it is generally accepted that producible oil reserves worldwide total about 1.5 trillion barrels, that supply will be exhausted in only 55 years at present consumption rates. Barely 1 percent of these reserves are in the United States, while 50 percent are located in the Middle East.

Hunter projected that the future of petroleum supplies lies in the 1.5 to 2 trillion barrels of oil that are locked in the Canadian oil sands (which are currently being produced using "steam assisted gravity drainage") and a similar amount of petroleum in U.S. oil shale deposits that cannot yet be tapped economically.

Hunter is the founder and president of Petroleum Equities Inc., and has spent more than 35 years in the oil industry.
