Today's Speaker

Hon. Craig W. Duehring USAF Colonel, DOD Official

Today we welcome the Hon. Craig W. Duehring, a retired Air Force colonel and DOD official.

Col. Duehring entered the Air Force in 1967, and by 1969 was flying in Vietnam and subsequently in the classified "Raven" program in Laos. His 4,400 flying hours include 1,525 combat hours and more than 800 combat sorties.

Subsequent assignments took him to Craig AFB, Ala., Langley AFB, Va., Maxwell AFB, Ala., RAF Bentwaters and RAF Woodbridge, UK, Germany, Spain, Indonesia, and Washington, D.C.

Col. Duehring retired from the Air Force in 1997, ran for Congress, and then worked on the 2000 Bush-Cheney campaign and transition team, joining the Administration in 2001.

He was appointed by President Bush to the position of Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Manpower and Reserve Affairs in 2007, a position he held until his retirement in April 2009. Among his many awards and decorations are the Silver Star and the Defense Superior Service Medal.
