This morning we welcome John Foust, a member of the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors who represents the Dranesville District. He also serves as chairman of the Fairfax County Economic Advisory Commission.

From 1981 until his election as a supervisor in 2007, John practiced

construction law in Northern Virginia and was active in several civic associations and county advisory committees.

Raised in Johnstown, Pa., John worked in the steel mills to pay for his education and was the first member of his family to go to college.

John earned a degree in economics from the University of Pittsburgh, an MBA from the West Virginia College of Graduate Studies, and a law degree from George Washington University.

- Assure the quality and accessibility of health services.
