Club Is Part of Rotary Team Helping 'Homestretch'



The Rotary Club of Tysons Corner has teamed with nine other local Rotary clubs to assist Homestretch, a nonprofit organization in Falls Church that provides transitional housing to homeless families in Fairfax County.

Club President Ingrid Parris-Hicklin (center right, above) and leaders of other clubs presented Homestretch officials with a check for \$10,527 to start a preschool program for the children of Homestretch families. The funds will purchase furniture, carpet, books, children's center supplies, and teachers' instructional materials. The goal of the "Kidstretch" center is to enable children to become kindergarten-ready so they can succeed in elementary school and beyond.

The facility will open in February 2012 in the Homestretch office building on Maple Avenue in Falls Church. Homestretch provides services for about 100 families.
