David Quegg Tibetan Children's Village Schools in India

Today we welcome David Quegg, who recently retired from the corps of educators serving in U.S. schools at embassies throughout the world.

David's final posting was in The American School, New Delhi, India, where he was a science teacher in middle school and junior high school. As a science teacher, he got involved with the Tibetan Children's Village (TCV) Schools in India, which our Club has supported with books and funds.

Through David and the University of Iowa Foundation, the TCV schools have obtained the servers and equipment needed to become connected to the U of Iowa's educational Internet service for rural areas.

David's final project with TCV is to find the funding for a server at the college that TCV has opened in Bangalor, India. This college provides career-focused education to train Tibetan students in computer sciences, accounting, nursing, and education.

Challenges in Nepal

A lower birth rate, higher productivity, and higher wages in rural areas are contributing to a brighter economic outlook for Nepal, Ambassador Shankar Sharma told the Club on May 31.

However, the political climate remains challenging. At its first session in May 2008, Nepal's Constituent Assembly abolished the monarchy and declared Nepal a democratic republic. But after failing to agree on a permanent constitution, the multiparty Assembly was dissolved on May 28, only three days before Dr. Sharma's presentation.

The United States and Nepal have enjoyed diplomatic relations since 1947. Dr. Sharma said.
