Changes Announced for Rotary Grants, Programs

Rotary International's Global Grants will get bigger – a minimum of \$25,000 per grant – and will focus on sustainable projects in Rotary's priority areas of economic development, clean water, education, peace, maternal and child health, and disease prevention. District grants will be at least \$5,000 each.

Those were among the changes announced on March 8 by President Ingrid Parris-Hicklin, who spoke on RI developments when the scheduled speaker failed to appear.

Ingrid also discussed the Guatemala Literacy Project, and noted that Rotary's Group Study Exchange program would now include domestic trips and shorter trips.
