# Robert K. Boggs, Ph.D. Foreign Affairs Analyst

Today we welcome Dr. Robert K. Boggs, professor at the Near East South Asia (NESA) Center for Strategic Studies. He joined NESA in 2008 after serving 32 years in the State Department as political officer and all-source intelligence analyst.

During his career, Dr. Boggs became one of the State Department's most experienced specialists in South Asia, having served in India (nine years), Sri Lanka, and Nepal. He headed the U.S. Embassy's Political Section in New Delhi and the U.S. Consulate General in Calcutta.

In Washington, Dr. Boggs served as Pakistan desk officer and as director of the Office of South Asian Regional Affairs. His last overseas assignment was as Deputy Chief of Mission in Kathmandu.

During almost four years in the Bureau of Intelligence and Research, Dr. Boggs was the State Department's political analyst for Pakistan and Bangladesh. He also has worked overseas or in Washington on Egypt, Central Africa, and Haiti.

Dr. Boggs holds an M.A. and Ph.D. in sociology from the University of California at Berkeley.
