Bob Hahne Stop Hunger Now

Today we welcome back Bob Hahne from the Rotary Club of McLean. Bob is planning another mega-meal-packing event for Nov. 5 to benefit Stop Hunger Now, a nonprofit international hunger-relief organization based in Raleigh, N.C.

Bob hopes to surpass the record 150,000 meals packaged at the most

recent event he conducted on June 11. The November meal marathon will take place once again at Redeemer Lutheran Church in McLean.

Bob held his first big event last November, where community volunteers packaged 100,000 meals in one day. That led to the even bigger event this past June.

Club Gets District Grant For 'Kidstretch' Program

Tyson's Corner is part of a 10-club team that has been awarded a District Simplified Grant (DSG) for a program called "Homestretch Preschool Program: Kidstretch." District 7610 is recommending a grant of \$7,000, with each club receiving \$700.

Kidstretch will be a day care center in Falls Church for the clients of Homestretch, which serves about 100 homeless families in Fairfax County.

The announcement was made Oct. 2 by Joseph A. Akkara, chair of the district's DSG program.
