Today's Speakers

Bob Lazaro & Jeff Carr INOVA Health System

Today we welcome Bob Lazaro and Jeff Carr, who will give us an update on the INOVA Health System.

INOVA comprises six hospitals: Alexandria, Fairfax, Fairfax for Children, Fair Oaks, Loudoun, and Mount Vernon. The system also operates stand-alone emergency rooms, urgent care centers, physical therapy centers, a heart and vascular institute, a medi-

cal center in Chantilly, and a nursing and rehabilitation center in Leesburg.

In 2009, INOVA handled 99,000 hospital admissions, 469,000 emergency room visits, and 21,000 births. The system had 16,123 employees and 5,391 nurses, with 3,412 physicians practicing at INOVA.

INOVA Loudoun Hospital announced Oct. 4 that it is under contract to purchase property to build a 24-hour full-service emergency department, diagnostic imaging center, and physician offices in the Ashburn community.
