Today's Speaker

Jamal Nough, Ph.D. Stratford University

This morning we welcome Dr. Jamal Nough of Straford University. He will discuss ways of partnering to improve relationships between the the West Bank of Jerusalem and "The West."

Dr. Nough graduated from Western Michigan University in 1990 with M.A. and Ph.D. degrees in graph theory and computer science.

In 1995 Dr. Nough became vice president of Al-Quds Open University. In 1999 he became executive IT director at the Central Bank/Jordan, leading IT projects funded by the World Bank and USAID. He later became executive IT director for the Banking Service Co. at the West Bank of Jordan.

For the past three years Dr. Nough has served as an adjunct professor at Stratford University's School of Computer Information Systems. He is also an adjunct at Strayer University.
