

# Hon. Thomas M. Davis III Gridlock in Washington

This morning we welcome the Hon. Thomas M. Davis III, former member of Congress, who will discuss the gridlock that has gripped Washington and slowed the work of Congress to a crawl.

Tom represented Virginia's 11th District in the U.S. House of Representatives from 1995 to 2008. He served as chairman of

the House Government Oversight and Reform Committee from 2003 to 2007. From 1998 to 2002 he chaired the National Republican Congressional Committee.

Tom was a member of the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors from 1980 to 1994, and served as chairman from 1991 to 1994. A native of Minot, N.D., Tom graduated from Amherst College and received his law degree from the University of Virginia Law School. He is married to a past president of our Club (2000-01), Jeannemarie Devolites Davis.
