

# Erin Leahy TransUrban, Inc.

This morning we welcome Erin Leahy from TransUrban, Inc. She will talk about the I-495 Express Lanes that are slated to open this year, and how they should provide a faster, more predictable trip on the Capital Beltway.

The I-495 Express Lanes are new high-occupancy toll (HOT) lanes that parallel existing lanes on the I-495/Capital Beltway and utilize the E-ZPass electronic toll-collection system.

The four new lanes on the Virginia side of the Capital Beltway run from the Springfield Interchange to just north of the Dulles Toll Road (approximately 14 miles).

The Express Lanes are being delivered through a public-private partnership between the Virginia Department of Transportation and Transurban-Fluor, and will give drivers the freedom to control how and when they arrive at their destination.
