Cindy Southworth National Network To End Domestic Violence

Today we welcome Cindy Southworth, vice president of development and innovation of the National Network to End Domestic Violence (NNEDV) in Washington, D.C.

NNEDV was founded more than 15 years ago to be the leading voice for survivors of domestic violence and their allies.

Cindy heads the communications, development, technology, and international efforts of NNEDV. She joined the nonprofit organization in 2002 when she founded the Safety Net Project to improve safety and privacy for victims in this digital age.

Cindy holds a Master's degree in social work and has worked to end violence against women for 20 years.

She serves on many task forces and committees, including the Justice Department's Privacy and Information Quality Working Group.
